If your child is starting school in September this year, please let us know which school they will attend once their placement has been confirmed.

National Offer Day when school decisions are made available is 17 April 2023. Appeals closing date is 12 May 2023 and mini admissions round to consider changes is 20 May 2023.

### Nut Free Setting

Please make sure that there is no food containing **nuts** in any lunch boxes as we have children at the setting that are allergic. We are a nut fee setting at all times. This includes chocolate spreads, peanut butter etc

### Names on Lunch Boxes and Water Bottles

Would parents please make sure to clearly put names on their child's lunch box and water bottle as it takes time trying to match water bottles to the correct child during lunch time. We want to avoid children drinking out of someone else's bottle!

# Paying Fees

Please remember that fees <u>must</u> be paid in advance of sessions attended. As per the policy, fees are now expected to be paid at least a half-term in advance. However, in some circumstances, it can be arranged for fees to be paid weekly. If your child is absent (half fees are payable in this instance) then any money remaining from what has been paid in advance will be credited to your account.

#### Term Dates

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### Warm, Spare and Labelled Clothes

Please ensure your child is sent in warm clothing and coats once the weather turns cold, as we will be spending much time outside. Please could you ensure that your child wears and has spare clothes that are ok to get dirty from playing each day and that the clothes (along with lunch boxes and any other items your child may bring) are labelled with your child's name (whatever you might have to hand!).

# Fees from April 2023

We have reviewed our fees, taking into account the cost of living and the increase in minimum wage from April 2023.

Therefore, from 1st April 2023 our hourly rate will be £5 which means a morning or afternoon session will be £12.50, morning and lunch will £17.50 and all day charges will be £30.

# Early Collection

If needed we can accommodate an earlier collection for your child in the afternoon. We are aware we have some families that need to do the school run in Hockwold. To make this possible we allow the child to be collected from Playgroup at 2:30pm.

Please note the collection time is either 2:30pm or 3pm and nothing in between.

#### Absent Child

We will get in touch with you via text message or phone call if your child is absent for two of their consecutive days without having informed us at Playgroup why they are not attending. This to make sure you and your child are ok.

### Bag for Each Child

Would you please make sure your child arrives with a bag with a spare set of clothes that are labelled. This will also allow us to have somewhere to put items from home or to be sent home.

### New Toys and Equipment

Thank you to all parents who participated in our fundraising events during the autumn term and the parents who kindly donated toys to our Playgroup.

We used the raised money to get a new climbing frame, a wooden tepee, dolls house furniture, dolls and mats. The donations we received included books, a book shelf a tea set and more. Thank you very much for your continuous support.
